### **WEED ABATEMENT**

Please have all hazardous vegetation and weeds removed no later than June 1<sup>st</sup> for fire safety and unsightly appearance and continue to keep them cut down. Failure to do so shall warrant the city to remove them and bill the property owner at a minimum of \$100 per tax lot.

### **OUTDOOR BURNING**

Any outdoor burning requires a permit which you can get at City Hall. No burning when it is windy or during other hazardous times. After June 1, burning must cease by 11:00 AM. From July 1 to November 1, no outdoor burning is allowed, unless the date is altered by the Maupin Fire Chief.
