There is still time to get signed up for high speed **broadband Internet**! They are offering connection speeds of 100Mb to 1Gb (1000Mb). Signing up ahead of time with GorgeNet or LSNetworks will get you connected with no connection fees. After July 1, that will cost \$100 for most connections, depending on your distance from the nearest fiber line. Crews are in and around Maupin now, getting the fiber in place to serve you. The backbone from the BPA substation to Maupin is done and they are finishing up the line to the cell towers. The technology hut inside the city reservoir yard is being wired and outfitted. The in-town work should begin very soon.

Please plan to come by if you are ready to sign up. They will take deposits and get you on their list.

Bryan Adams of LSNetworks will be in Maupin on the following dates from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM to meet with potential customers. Wednesday, April 19th; Tuesday May 6th; Thursday, May 18th. More dates to follow. He will be at the shop next to the driveway at The Oasis Café.

With the coming of high-speed Internet connections, I wanted to make sure our businesses, entrepreneurs, and citizens all had some ideas on what that might mean for them. Our Business Facilitator, Rick Leibowitz is working on a series of classes to address this need. On March 7th from 9:00-11:00, he held a social media class and more are planned in the future. Rick works out of the Small Business Development Center at CGCC and is available to provide individual, confidential assistance to anyone considering starting or improving a business here in Maupin.

In late March, we met with the Oregon Regional Solutions personnel and representatives from several state agencies to learn how the state can assist Maupin with funding to meet some of our infrastructure improvement needs. This is the same group that helped secure funding for the broadband fiber project. We are quite hopeful now to get their assistance with water, sewer, and street projects plus some others in the near future.

The School District has several public events going on in April:

- April 10th 14th the Missoula Children's Theater will be working with students and a community performance will take place Friday evening.
